Jeff Champoux, and Paul Cham-poux.

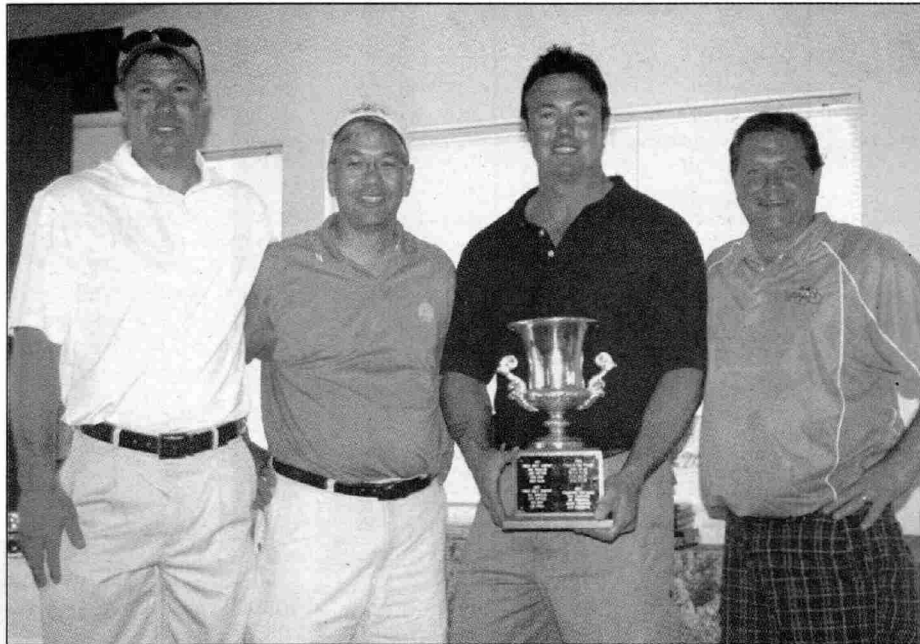
